- Providing all levels of management, employees and contractors with the knowledge and skills to carry out their HSEC roles and responsibilities.
- Establish consultation mechanisms that enable management, employees and contractors to contribute to the effective management of HSEC.
- Developing appropriate communication systems for the provision of information including regularly reviewed Policies, Standards, HSEC System Procedures, Safe Operating Procedures, Guidelines and reporting and feedback mechanisms to guide the management of Health and Safety.
- Where required the effective use of appropriate internal and / or external expertise.
- Provision of equitable claims management, effective consultation and sustainable rehabilitation and return to work programs for employees who have suffered work related injuries.
